



Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training

Objectives of ASIST Training:

ASIST trainings are taught through lecture, group and interactive role playing settings. Participants will learn how to:

- Recognize warning signs.
- Engage help and talk to someone thinking about suicide.
- Keep others safe and seek further assistance by utilizing appropriate community resources.

Important Training Information:

- Training begins each day at 8:30 AM and ends at 4:30 PM.
- Trainings register a *minimum* of 6 people total and a *maximum* of 14 people total.
- All participants are asked to respect others and limit use of electronics during training.
