

## **IMPORTANT UPDATE** September 8, 2021

Third doses of the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines are now available to immunocompromised GRIC and Ak-Chin Indian Community tribal enrolled members and their household members, and all federally recognized tribal members.


You are eligible to receive an additional (third) dose if you have:

Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood

Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)



Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response (such as Enbrel, Humira)
