Third Vaccine Dose

IMPORTANT UPDATE

September 8, 2021

Third doses of the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines are now available to immunocompromised GRIC and Ak-Chin Indian Community tribal enrolled members and their household members, and all federally recognized tribal members.

You are eligible to receive an additional (third) dose if you have:

- ✓ Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- ✓ Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- ✓ Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- ✓ Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- ✓ Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- ✓ Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response (such as Enbrel, Humira)
