



COVID-19 VACCINE BOOSTER UPDATE

3rd dose Pfizer & Moderna COVID vaccines are available:

Booster Eligibility

If you received the...	Then...	When to get a booster?
Pfizer	You are eligible for a booster if you are: 12 and up and...	Five (5) months after your second shot of Pfizer
Moderna	You are eligible for a booster if you are: 18 and up and...	Five (5) months after your second shot of Moderna
Johnson & Johnson	You are eligible for a booster* if you are: 18 years of age or order. *Pfizer or Moderna only	Two (2) months after your first shot

For Severe Immunocompromised

Eligible for	If You Received Pfizer	If You Received Moderna
Additional Primary Shot	People age 5+ who are moderately or severely immunocompromised should get an additional primary shot of Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. Given 28 days after 2nd shot.	People age 18 + who are moderately or severely immunocompromised should get an additional primary shot of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine. Given 28 days after 2nd shot.
