AK-CHIN CLINIC – CLOSED DUE TO WATER MAIN BREAK

Gila River Health Care was notified at 1 pm on 11/3/16 about a water main break within the Ak-Chin Indian Community. There is no water service at the Ak-Chin Clinic. Gila River Health Care is unable to provide service at the clinic at this time. The clinic will re-open once water services are restored.

About the Gila River Indian Community

Located thirty-five miles south of Phoenix, Arizona, in the Community of Sacaton, Gila River Health Care is a not-for-profit corporation chartered under the auspices of the Gila River Indian Community Tribal government to serve American Indian communities. Today, the organization is comprised of **Hu Hu Kam Memorial Hospital**, a 15-bed critical access hospital designation located in Sacaton, Arizona. This facility provides a wide range of primary health care services to its populations including a state-of-the-art dialysis unit and comprehensive behavioral health services. **The Ak-Chin Clinic** is located within the Ak-chin Indian Community to provide this population with primary health care services. The **Komatke Health Center**, located in Komatke, Arizona, opened in January of 2009 to replace the Gila Cross Clinic and to expand its services to the area. It provides a number of comprehensive primary health services, a state-of-the-art dialysis unit and extensive behavioral health services.
