

COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE:

OMICRON 2ND BOOSTER SHOT NOW AVAILABLE FOR ELDERS

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- o Elders 65 years of age and older can now receive a second Omicron booster shot four months after the first Omicron booster shot
- o Unvaccinated individuals six years of age and above only need a single Omicron booster shot to complete COVID-19 vaccination; no need for multiple doses
- o Most individuals under 65 years of age who have already received one Omicron booster shot are up-to-date and do not need additional Omicron booster shots

Children under six years of age and individuals with medical conditions that cause weakened immunity (cancer chemotherapy, transplant, etc.) should contact their healthcare provider for COVID-19 vaccine recommendations.
